Open students' eyes to a future full of career possibilities through JA Inspire on October 23rd!

We invite you to include your students in *JA Inspire*, Junior Achievement's in-depth career exploration program for students offered at no cost to you. The program is a real-world way to envision future career opportunities. It consists of three segments: 1) in-class sessions presented by the classroom teacher; 2) the hands-on career fair; and 3) an in-class debrief. Students' eyes will be opened to the importance of career planning and how to research new and exciting careers.

Junior Achievement has partnered with employers from our region, who are ready to inform students about careers and jobs at their companies during the event. At the career fair, students will engage with local business volunteers and participate in hands-on activities, often using actual equipment or tools their employees use on the job. The students learn what certain jobs entail and begin to imagine their futures in the context of these career opportunities.

JA Inspire helps teachers engage with students on a deeper level by:

- Aiding teachers in their career-readiness efforts.
- Supporting academic standards in work readiness, with a secondary focus on social studies, business, reading, and writing.
- Equipping educators with classroom sessions before the virtual career fair so students get the most out of the experience.

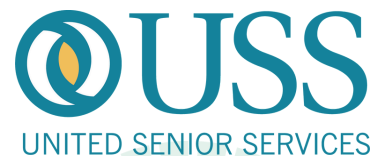
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
